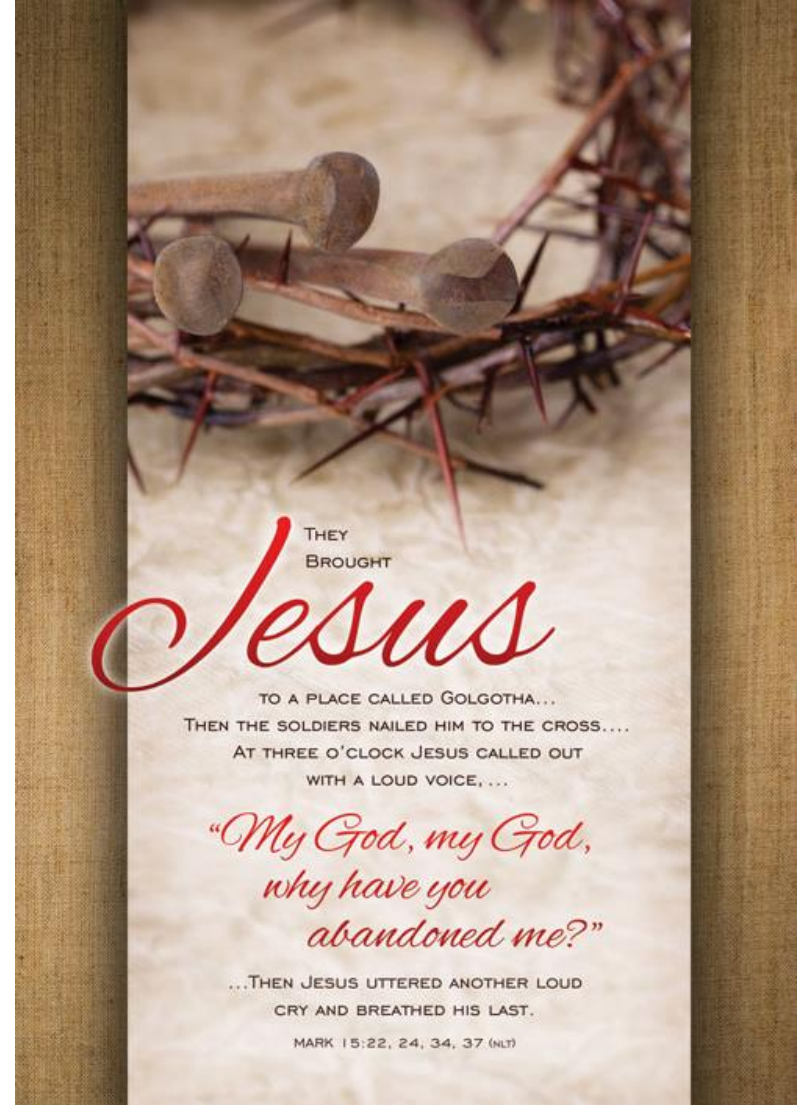
## AFFIRMATION OF FAITH
