State Guidance

The PA governor has given Allegheny County the yellow phase status, effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 15. Religious organizations have been given “essential” status since the beginning, with the request that we only open for essential functions and remain closed for large gatherings. That being said, you will receive advance notice regarding the earliest date for in person worship services. Sunday, May 31, 2020 is still a “tentative” date. “Be strong and take heart, all you who hope in the LORD” (Psalm 31:24).
