Declaring God's Grace & Demonstrating God's Love, as Directed by God's Word

Welcome to Worship!

We welcome each of you to Ken Mawr Church! Most people who ask, "How can I know God's will for my life?" are really asking, "How can I find guidance from the Lord for my life choices and decisions?" In Acts 8, Philip shows us how. It requires our receptivity to the Spirit's direction and a willingness to accept that direction. Often the guidance we get does not fit our practicality or preferences. But the direction from the Lord's messenger in verse 26 couldn't be clearer: "Go South to the road—the desert road—that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." Philip already knew that Gaza was to the south, but the instruction to go on the sunbaked Gaza road in the desert seemed strange. The underlying issue in this passage is Philip's obedience. We usually don't know what the Lord has planned as far as the circumstances into which he leads us, so our obedience requires total trust. Once again, I welcome you! -Pastor Karl

Today at KMUPC

GOD'S WORD READ AND PROCLAIMED

Scripture Acts 8:26-40

26 Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, "Go south to the road—the desert road—that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." 27 So he started out, and on his way he met an Ethiopian eunuch, an important official in charge of all the treasury of the Kandake (which means "queen of the Ethiopians"). This man had gone to Jerusalem to worship, 28

and on his way home was sitting in his chariot reading the Book of Isaiah the prophet. 29 The Spirit told Philip, "Go to that chariot and stay near it." 30 Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. "Do you understand what you are reading?" Philip asked. 31 "How can I," he said, "unless someone explains it to me?" So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him. 32 This is the passage of Scripture the eunuch was reading: "He was led like a sheep to the slaughter, and as a lamb before its shearer is silent, so he did not open his mouth. 33 In his humiliation he was deprived of justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth." 34 The eunuch asked Philip, "Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?" 35 Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus. 36 As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. What can stand in the way of my being baptized?" 38 And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him. 39 When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way rejoicing. 40 Philip, however, appeared at Azotus and traveled about, preaching the gospel in all the towns until he reached Caesarea. THE SERVICE OF BAPTISM

Hear the words of the LORD Jesus Christ:

All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the close of the age.

The Meaning of Baptism:

As they are united with Christ through faith, Baptism unites the people of God with each other and with the church of every time and place. Baptism enacts and seals what the Word proclaims: God's redeeming grace offered to all people. Baptism is God's gift of grace and also God's summons to respond to that grace.

Do you, the members of this congregation, in the name of the whole church of Christ, undertake with this parent the Christian nurture of this child so that in due time she may confess faith in Jesus Christ. (We do.)

Will you endeavor by your example and fellowship to strengthen their family ties with the household of God? (We will.)
