## Welcome to Worship!

Welcome to worship. This is the day that the Lord has made; Let us rejoice and be glad in it. In today's message from 2 Corinthians, Paul refers to human beings as earthen vessels or lowly jars of clay. Instead of creating us to be strong, independent creatures to express our own wonderful characteristics, God created us to be weak, limited, earthen vessels so that in Christ, he could be the treasure within us that shines out of us. Since clay jars are formed by hand, they most likely have imperfections. The same can be said for each of us; yet God chooses to enclose his treasure in our ordinary, breakable, often-flawed vessels. That treasure is the incredible message of the gospel: God's Good News of forgiveness and the promise of eternal life. Let His light shine through our imperfections.
